



Member Organization Job Description Prerequisites / Requirements of Members

(Per bylaws IV. 4.: The MCC Board of Directors shall approve membership requirements)

- 1) Membership is open to any organization whose mission is not in conflict with the MCC's priority objectives and which meets all membership requirements. [Reference IV. 1.]
- 2) Only organizations are eligible to be members. [Reference IV. 2.]
- 3) Member organizations must endorse and support the implementation of all MCC priority objectives, and must provide a written confirmation of proposed activities to address one or more of the priority objectives.
- 4) Member organizations shall strive to coordinate and collaborate within their own and with other organizations to implement strategies that address one or more of the MCC priority objectives.
- 5) Each member organization shall designate a representative and may designate an alternate, both of whom are encouraged to attend all meetings. [Reference IV. 3.]
- 6) The designated organization representative shall have continuous access to the organization's decision makers, keeping them informed on MCC activities and matters of importance, and reflecting the interests of the organization back to the MCC.
- 7) Member organizations shall advocate for cancer control education, activities, funding, and legislation that will help the MCC achieve its cancer control priorities.
- 8) Members must provide annual reports about progress and accomplishments.
- 9) Member organizations may continue as members as long as they meet membership requirements [Reference IV. 5.] and comply with the bylaws.
