

Single Sign-On Password Modifications

Based on recent audit findings, DTMB will be implementing new password policies for the Single Sign-On (SSO) web portal. This change impacts users of approximately 70 applications across seven State agencies. Total users affected is 190,000.

Current configuration:

1. Minimum password length is five (5).
2. Passwords are case sensitive.
3. Maximum number of repeated characters is two (2).
4. Password cannot be same as userid or user name.
5. New password cannot be same as current password

New configuration:

- 1. Minimum password length is eight (8).**
- 2. Password must contain at least one letter and one number.**
3. Passwords are case sensitive.
4. Maximum number of repeated characters is two (2).
5. Password cannot be same as userid or user name.
6. New password cannot be same as current password.

Implementation date for new configuration: August 1st, 2011.

Beginning August 1st and after, users will be required to change their password to the new configuration when their existing password expires.

Communication will be offered to SSO users through login screens, through application announcements screens (such as the CHAMPS MyInbox alert texts), and through the State of Michigan web site. Additional communication may also be offered.
