



WISEWOMAN Program
Performance Measures
Fiscal Year 2012
October 1, 2011 to September 30, 2012

Each organization's Fiscal Year (FY) 2013 caseload allocation will, in part, be determined by how well that organization achieves the performance measure goals in FY 2011. Organizations that meet their performance measures, will maintain their current caseload (dependent on funding from CDC) and have the option of receiving more caseload (based on availability). Organizations that do not meet or show significant progress toward meeting their performance measures will be in danger of losing caseload.

Screening

- Each organization must meet **at least 95%** of budgeted caseload without going over.
- **At least 95%** of participants must have all screening and enrollment data. This includes all Health History and Health Risk form data, height, weight, two blood pressure readings, fasting status, cholesterol, HDL, glucose (or Hemoglobin A1C), and pulse regularity.
- **At least 95%** of participants receive appropriate medical referrals. (Refer to Screening and Referral Protocols for more information.)

Lifestyle Intervention

- **At least 90%** of Level 3 participants will develop Healthy Lifestyle Goals.
- **At least 75%** of Level 3 participants will receive a minimum of two follow-up lifestyle counseling contacts (in addition to developing Healthy Lifestyle Goals).
- **At least 75%** of Level 2 participants will receive one follow-up contact after screening.
- **At least 75%** of Level 1 participants will receive one contact at screening.
- **At least 90%** of all participants will be referred to Michigan State University Extension's Family Nutrition Program or an approved community resource.
- **Less than 20%** of Level 3 participants will have a status of "Can't Contact" or "Refused."

Women with Alert Values (Blood Pressure **>180** (systolic) **and/or** **>110** (diastolic) and/or Total Cholesterol **>400** and/or Glucose **<50** or Glucose **> 275**)

- **100%** of all participants with an alert screening value will be seen for a diagnostic exam within one week of screening. Documentation is required for alert participants who are not seen for a diagnostic exam within one week. (Refer to Medical Care Case Management Protocols for more information.)

Rescreening

- **At least 35%** of WISEWOMAN participants are rescreened 12 – 18 months following a previous WISEWOMAN screening. (Refer to Rescreening Policy for more information.)
